5. Code of Conduct

All stakeholders of the Club abide by this code of conduct and it should be referred to now and again for any type of decision making or conflict resolution related to the Club. It should also be rectified and updated when necessary.

1. The club should always work towards the betterment of the students.
2. Club's activities must align with the Club's Vision and Mission.
3. Decision-making:

Core members along with the faculty coordinator have decision-making rights. Decisions would be made by the process of voting.

- a. The faculty coordinator has the veto power which can be exercised during conflict resolution or any other critical circumstances.
- b. President has more decision-making power than the Vice President which is greater than that of executive members and associate members.
- c. All executive members have the same decision power which is more than that of associate members.
- d. All associate members have no decision power of their own. But they have the right to vote in the club's decision-making process.
- e. Non-core members are not expected to participate in the club's decision-making process in any way. Hence they also don't have the right to vote.

- f. The faculty coordinator is not expected to participate in the voting unless in the case of a tie, where he/she can exercise one vote to determine the result.
4. Any student(including core members, associate members, and members) who is guilty of hindering the Club's activities with evil motives can be restricted from the Club's membership and participation in any further activities. Such students must be convicted of such acts by following the Club's standard decision-making process.
5. Clubs' membership and activities are always open to every student of the institute except those students who are found guilty according to point-4.
6. The club is expected to foster sub-communities based on specific technical domains in the future.
7. Passing on the legacy:
 - a. The current core team is supposed to select the next core team at least one semester before their graduation.
 - b. Priority should be given to associate members and members of the Club in the selection of the next core team.
 - c. All the new core members must be selected based on interviews by the current core team and faculty coordinator.
8. Club members should always use inclusive language and behave responsibly as the representatives of the institute. If they're found guilty of any kind of unethical or disgraceful behavior, they'll be immediately removed from the club.
9. The club will have regular meetings at least twice every month.
10. The club will maintain minutes of all the club meetings.
11. Club will submit a detailed report to the Head faculty coordinator and Principal Sir after every event.



1. The club should always work towards the betterment of the students.
2. Club's activities must align with the Club's Vision and Mission.
3. Decision-making:
Core members along with the faculty coordinator have decision making rights. Decisions would be made by the process of voting.
 - a) The faculty coordinator has the veto power which can be exercised during conflict resolution or any other critical circumstances.
 - b) The President has the final decision making power and the Vice president has decision-making power which is greater than that of executive members and associate members.
 - c) All executive members have the same decision power which is more than that of associate members.
 - d) All associate members have no decision power of their own. But they have the right to vote in the club's decision making process.
 - e) Non-core members are not expected to participate in the club's decision-making process in any way. Hence they also don't have the right to vote.
 - f) The faculty coordinator is not expected to participate in the voting unless in the case of a tie, where he/she can exercise one vote to determine the result.
4. Any student (including core members, associate members, and members) who is guilty of hindering the club's activities with evil motives can be restricted from the club's membership and participation in any further activities. Such students must be

convicted of such acts by following the club's standard decision making process.

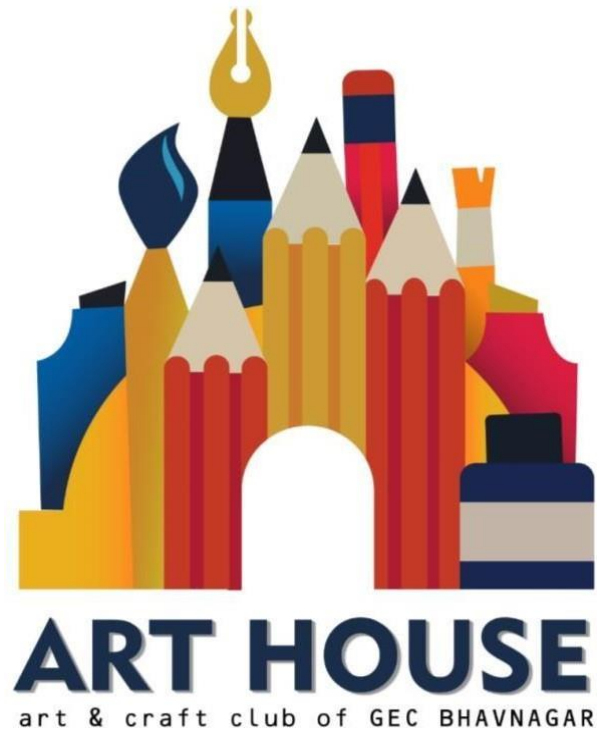

5. Code of Conduct

All stakeholders of the Dance Club must adhere to this code of conduct, which should be referred to regularly for decision-making or conflict resolution. The code should also be reviewed and updated as necessary.

1. The Dance Club will always strive to promote and enhance the creative and technical growth of its members in dance and foster a passion for performing arts among the student community.
2. All Dance Club activities must align with the Club's Vision and Mission, which focus on celebrating dance as a form of art, promoting cultural exchange, and providing a platform for students to showcase their talent.
3. Decision-making:

Core members and the faculty coordinator have decision-making rights. Decisions will be made through voting.

Dance club of GEC Bhavnagar

- a. The **faculty coordinator** holds veto power to resolve conflicts or manage critical situations.
 - b. The **President** has more decision-making authority than the Vice President, followed by executive members and associate members.
 - c. **Executive members** have equal decision-making power, which is greater than that of associate members.
 - d. **Associate members** cannot independently make decisions but have the right to vote in the decision-making process.
 - e. **Non-core members** do not participate in the decision-making process or voting.
 - f. The faculty coordinator is not expected to participate in the voting unless **in the case of a tie**, where he/she can exercise one vote to determine the result.
4. Any member (including core members, associate members, or general members) found guilty of hindering the club's activities with malicious intent will face membership termination. Such cases will be resolved using the standard decision-making process.
 5. The Dance Club welcomes all students of the institute to participate in its activities, except those found guilty of misconduct under point 4.
 6. The Dance Club is encouraged to foster sub-communities based on dance styles (e.g., classical, contemporary, hip-hop, etc.) to promote diversity and skill specialization.
 7. Passing on the legacy:
 - a. The current core team must select the next core team at least one semester before their graduation.
 - b. Priority will be given to associate members and active participants in the club for core team roles.
 - c. Selection of new core members will involve interviews conducted by the current core team and the faculty coordinator.
 8. Dance Club members must always use inclusive language and represent the institute responsibly. Any unethical or disgraceful behavior will result in immediate removal from the club.

9. The club will hold regular meetings at least twice a month to discuss activities, events, and other matters.
10. Minutes of all meetings will be documented and maintained by the club for record-keeping and reference.
11. The Dance Club will submit a detailed report to the Head Faculty Coordinator and Principal after every event, summarizing activities, achievements, and feedback.
12. The club will maintain a detailed and accurate record of all financial transactions. These records will be presented to the Head Faculty Coordinator and Principal when requested.

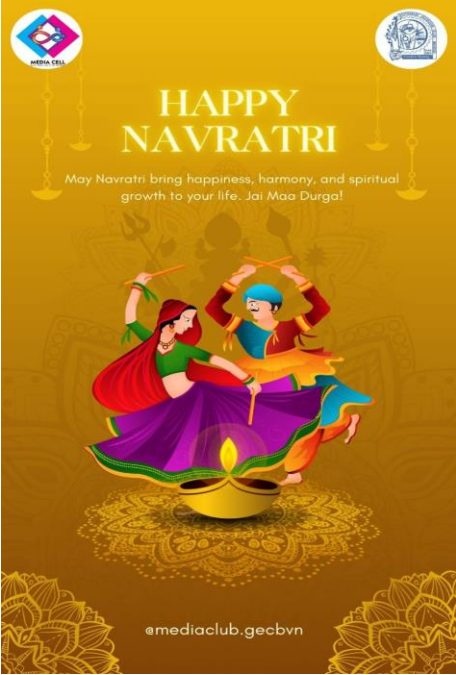
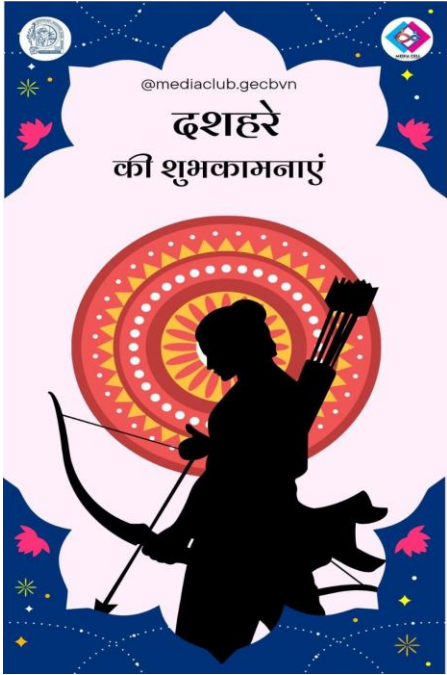
